

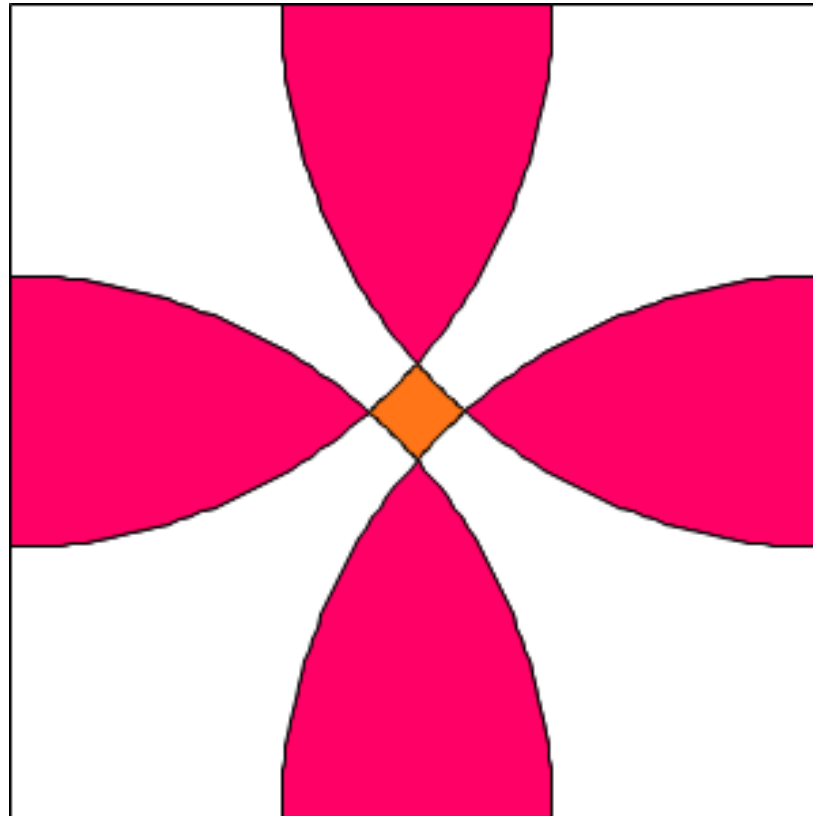

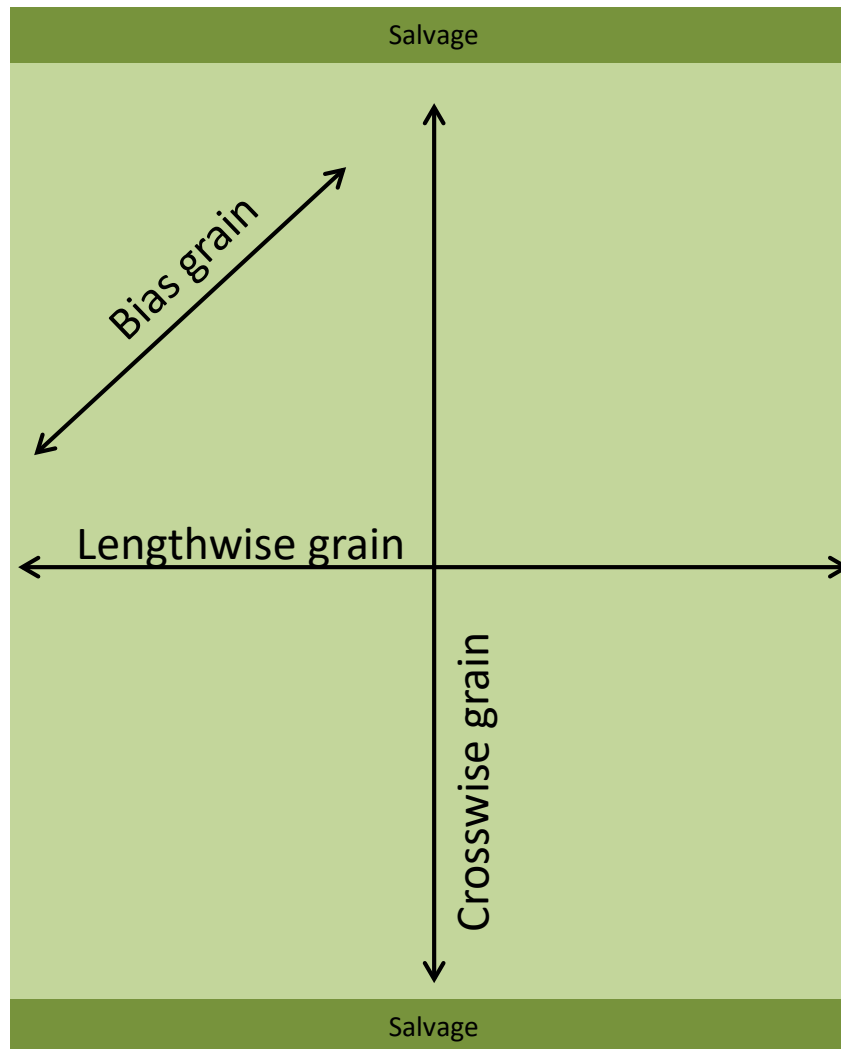

Introducing the Flowering Snowball Block



Crosswise versus Lengthwise Grain



Cutting with the GO! Cutter

- Run your fabric through so it cuts on the “Lengthwise Grain” of the fabric
- Remember Selvage to your Belly!



Cutting Instructions

– From Fabric #1 cut:

- (8) 14" x WOF Strips. Subcut into (80) Piece A

– From Fabric #2 cut:

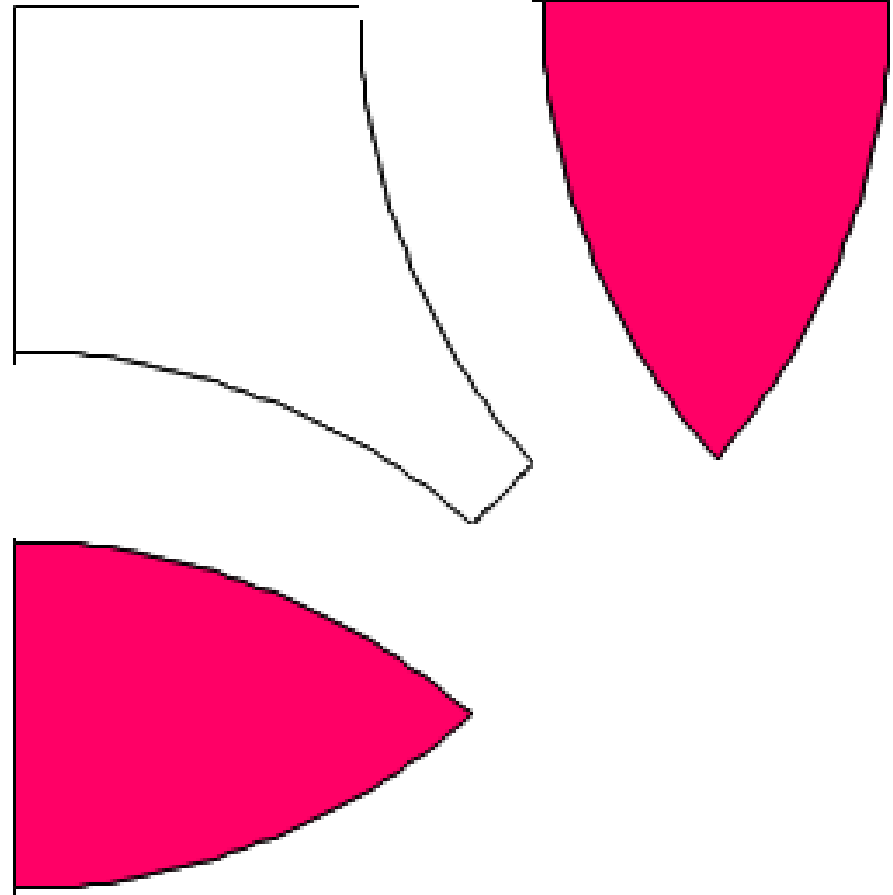
- (5) 6-3/4" x WOF Strips. Subcut into (40) Piece B

– From Fabric #3 cut:

- (5) 6-3/4" x WOF Strips. Subcut into (40) Piece B
- (1) 2" x WOF Strip. Subcut into (2) Piece C

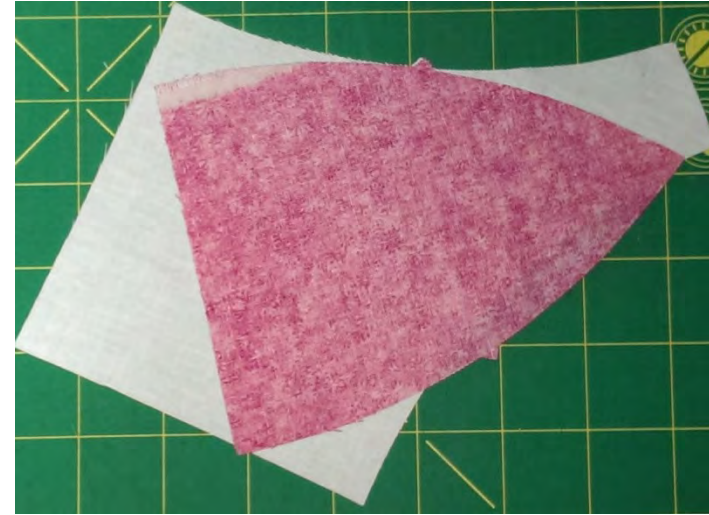
Sewing Unit #1

- Layout (1) Fabric #1
Piece A and (2) Fabric #2
Piece B as shown.



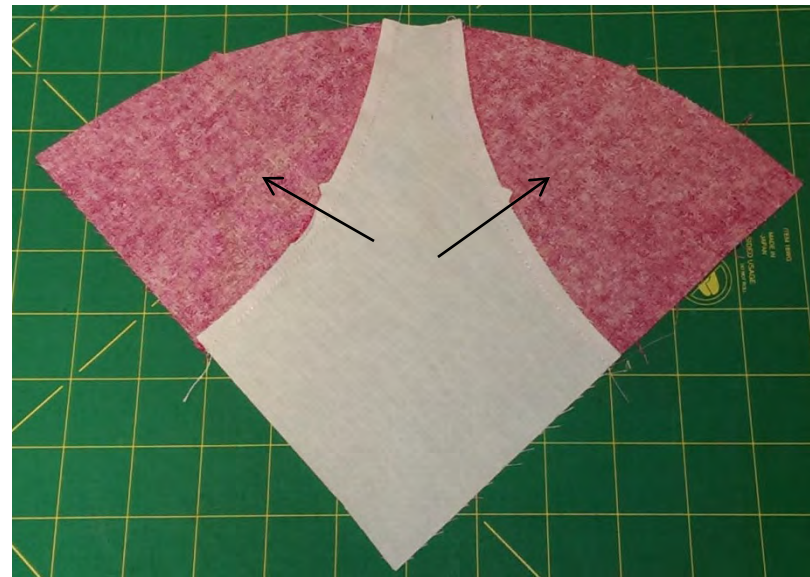
Sewing Unit #1

- Lay (1) Fabric #2 Piece B on top of (1) Fabric #1 Piece A lining up the notches.
- Pin and sew together
Pressing towards Piece B



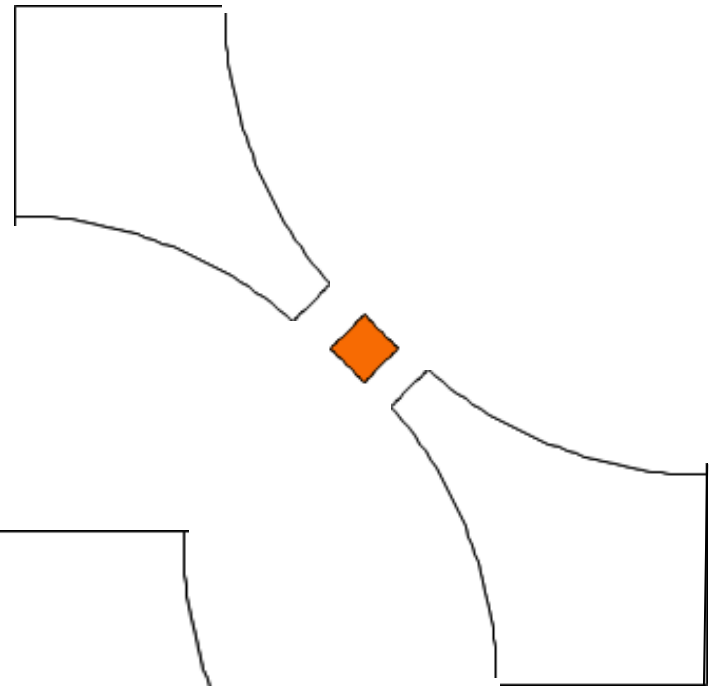
Sewing Unit #1

- Layer (1) Fabric #2 Piece B on the other side of Fabric #1 Piece A.
- Line up notches, pin and sew together.
- Press towards Piece B
- Make (2) of Unit #1

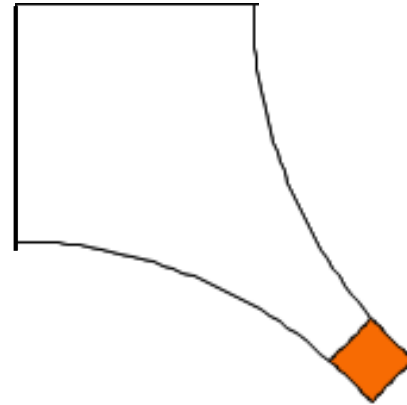


Sewing Unit #2

- Layout (2) Fabric #1 Piece A and (1) Fabric #3 Piece C as shown.

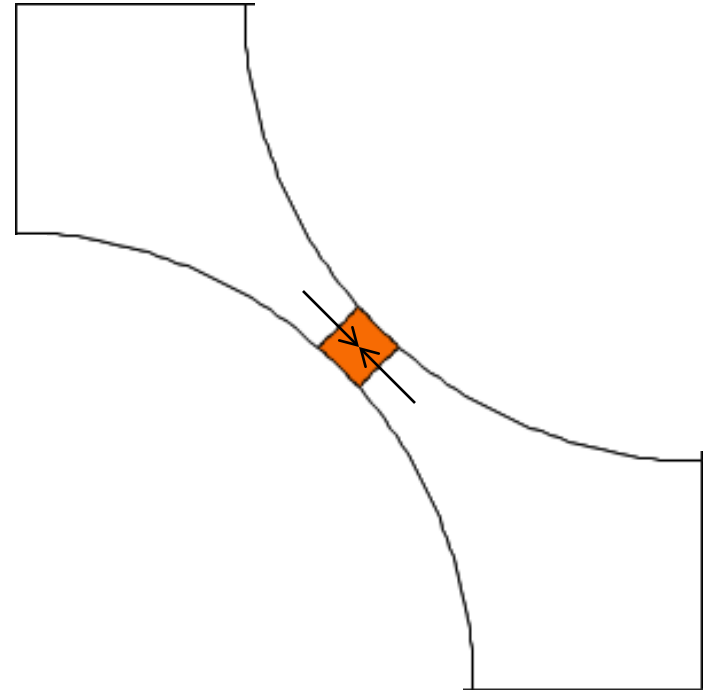


- Sew (1) Fabric #3 Piece C to the short end of (1) Piece A



Sewing Unit #2

- Sew (1) Piece A to opposite side of Piece C.
- Press seams towards the piece C



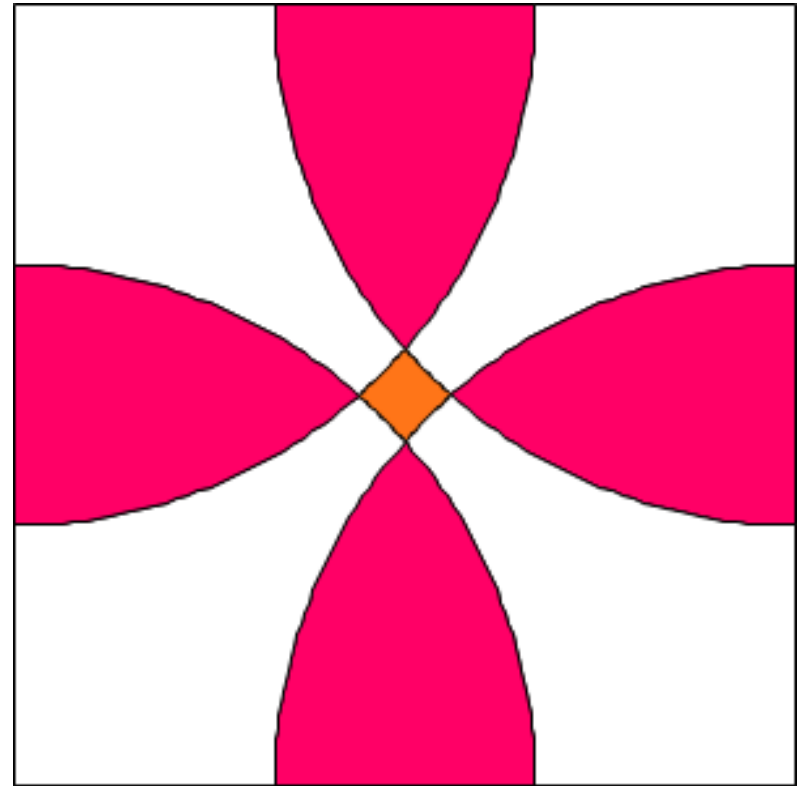
Sewing Block 1

- Layout (2) Unit #1 and (1) Unit #2 as shown.
- Lay Unit #2 on top of (1) Unit #1 lining up notches (Center seams should nest also). Pin and sew together.
- Press towards Unit #2



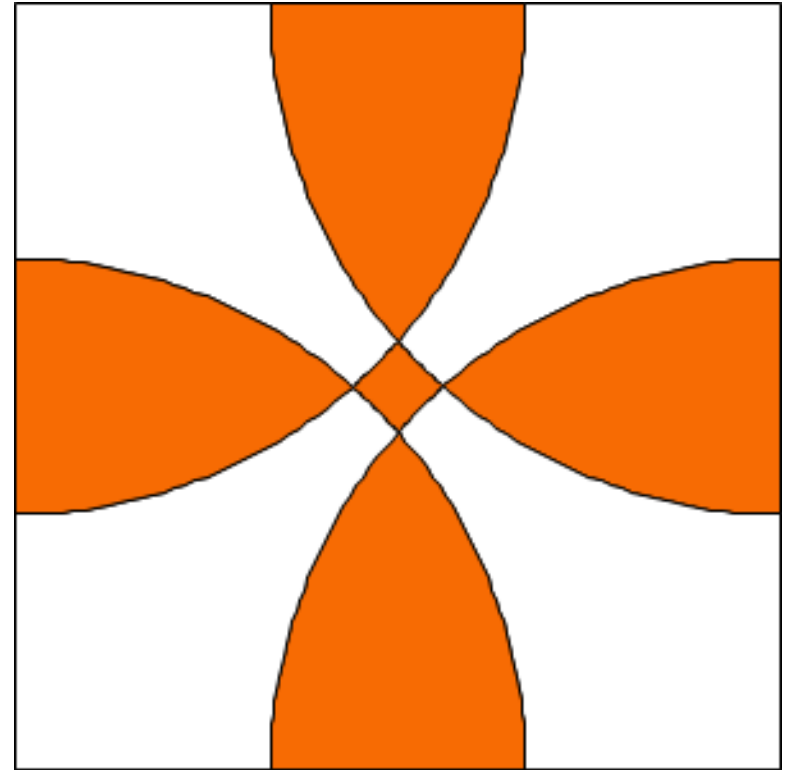
Sewing Block 1

- Layer (1) Unit #1 on the other side of Unit #2. Line up notches, pin, and sew together. Press towards Unit #2.
- Block should Measure 12-1/2" x 12-1/2"
- Repeat to make a total of (10) Block #1



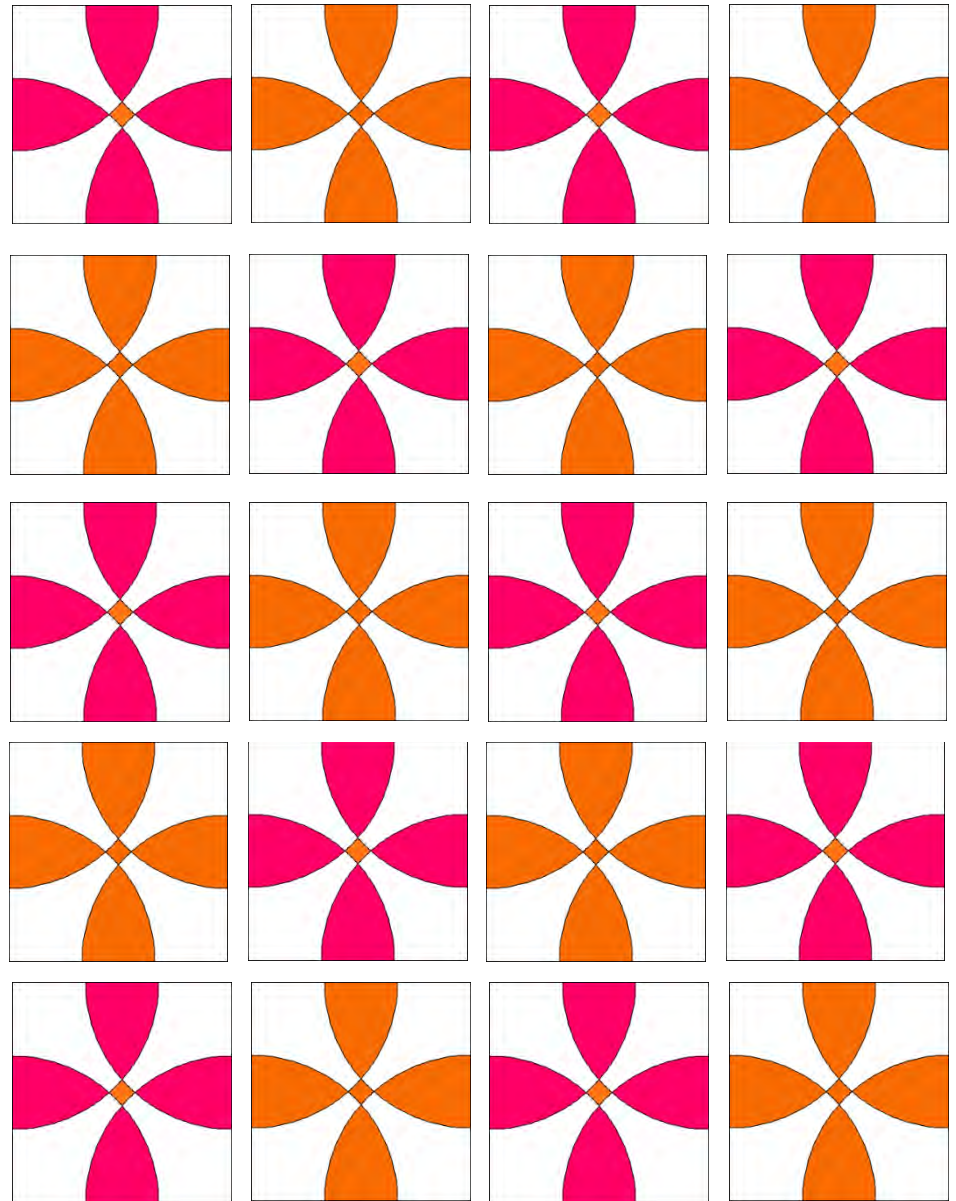
Sewing Block #2

- Repeat previous steps with remaining Fabric and make (10) Block #2



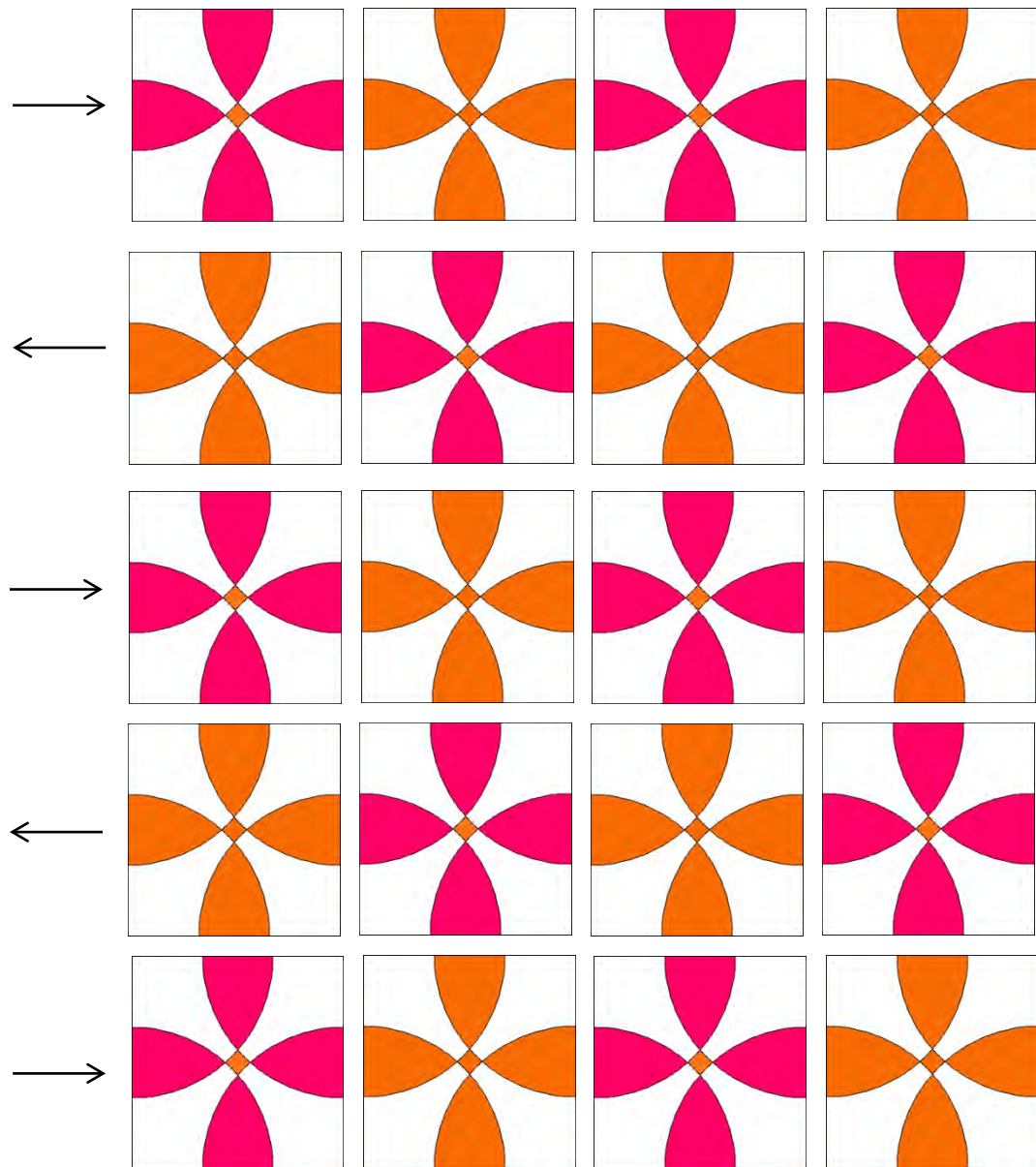
Sewing Quilt top together

- Layout (10) Block #1 and (10) Block #2 as shown.



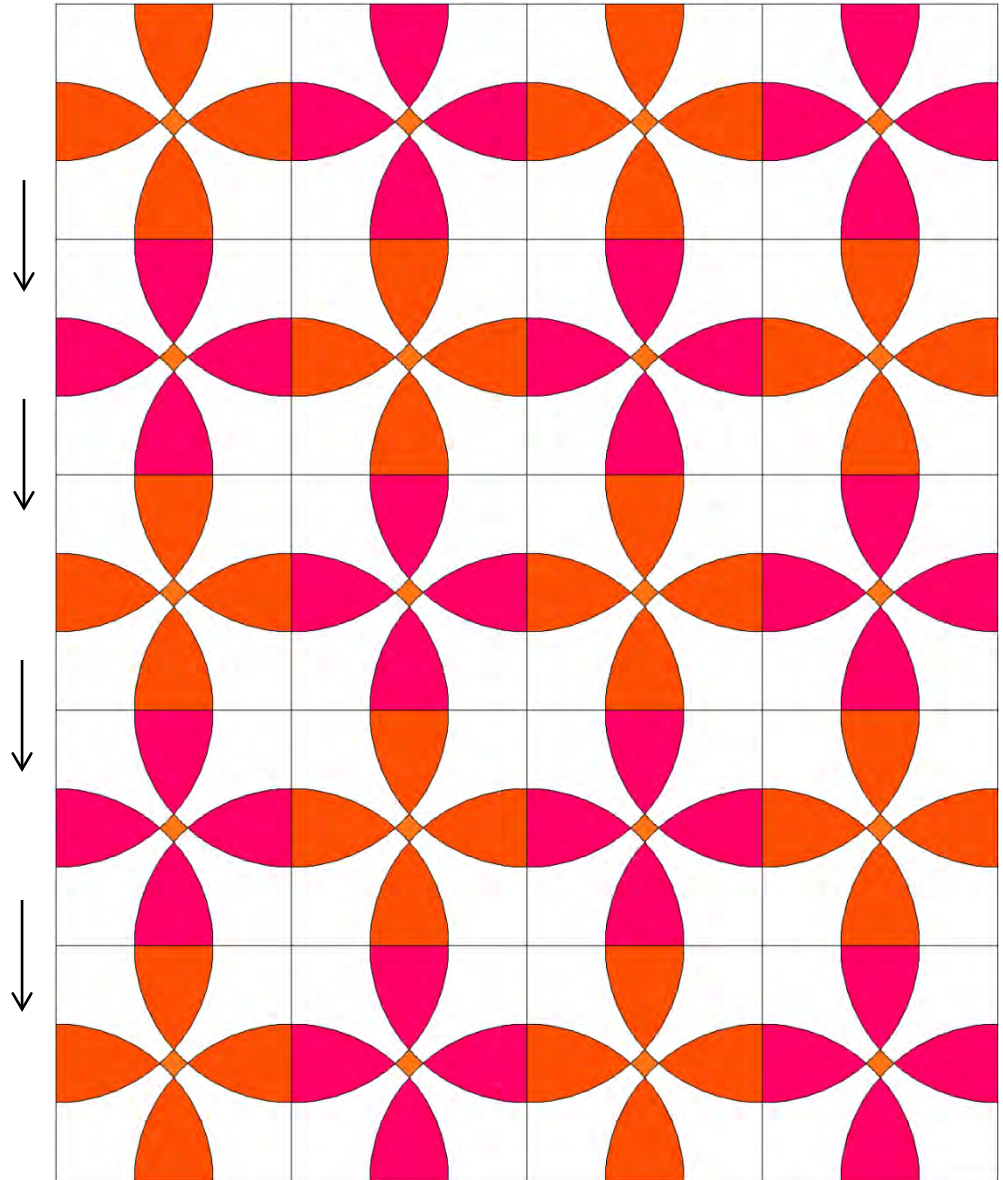
Sewing Quilt top together

- Sew blocks into rows
pressing seams in
opposite directions.



Sewing Quilt top together

- Sew rows together pressing seams in the same direction.

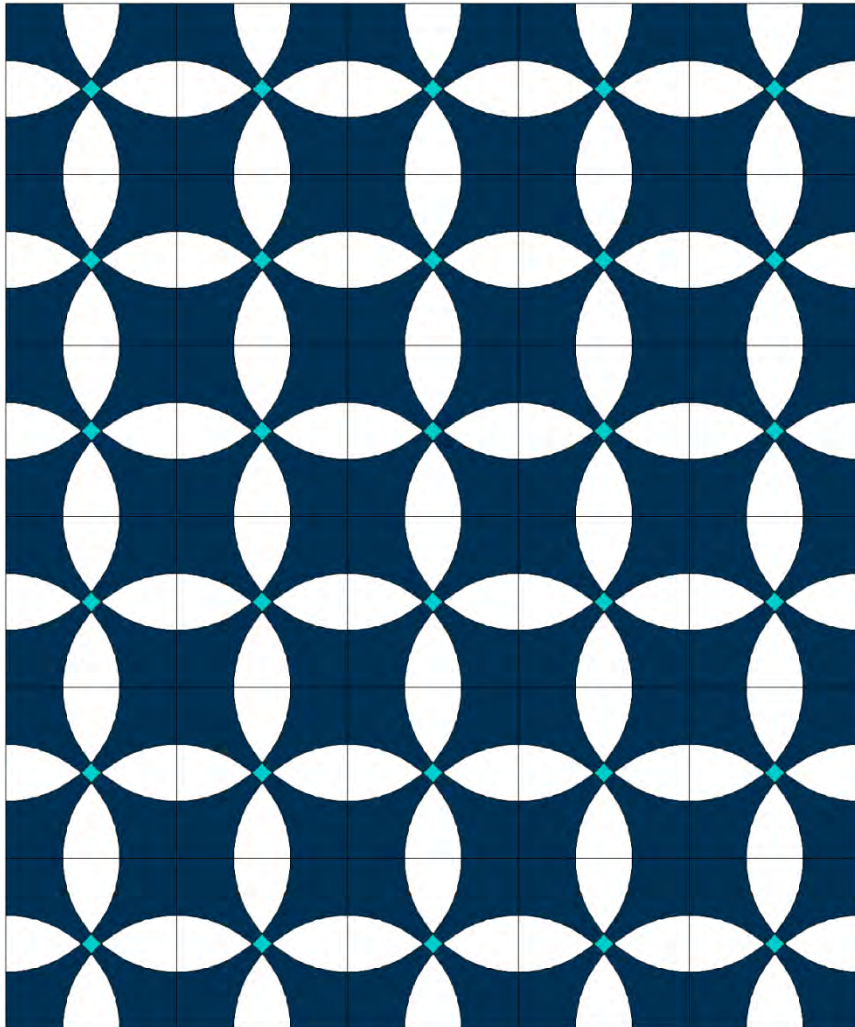


The Finishing Touches

- Layer quilt with backing and batting
- Quilt as Desired.
- Attach binding mitering the corners.



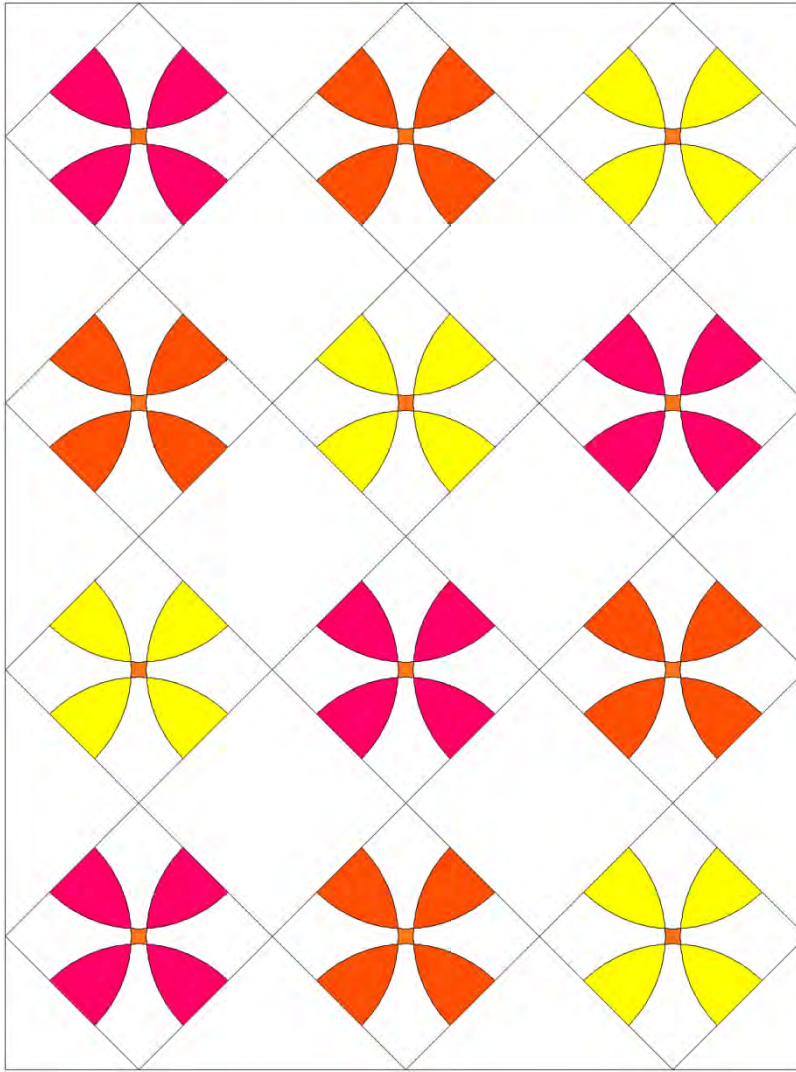
